

Volt Credit Union will award a \$1,000 scholarship to an outstanding Hillcrest student to aid them in their pursuit of higher education during the 2025-2026 school year. Scholarships are a single monetary reward to be applied to the cost of tuition, books, and/or lab fees (if applicable). The Volt Credit Union Scholarship is open to Hillcrest students who plan to continue their education at an accredited university, college or technical school. Volt Credit Union employees, Board and Committee Members, and their spouses or children are not eligible for the scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements

Must be a Hillcrest High School Student Graduating in 2025

- Must be registered to attend an accredited college, university, or technical college in the United States as a full time student in the 2025-2026 school year.
- Must provide verification of acceptance to a school before scholarship funds are disbursed.

Application Requirements

Eligible students must complete and return the following materials no later than Monday, March 31, 2025.

- 🐇 Scholarship application form
- Photo of the applicant. (Photo will not be used for judging purposes. Photo may be used to announce the winner).
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, a guidance counselor, employer or member of the clergy. The letter should include the author's relationship to the applicant and how long they have known the applicant.
- An essay on: "What is the value of a local credit union?" The essay should be no more than 500 words in length, and must be typed and double spaced.

Award Information

The winner will be notified by telephone or mail on or before April 19, 2025. The recipient will be invited to Volt Credit Union's Annual Membership Meeting for special recognition. Scholarship funds will be sent to the post-secondary school in the student's name upon confirmation of enrollment.
