

Volt Credit Union will award two \$1,000 scholarship to an outstanding Volt Credit Union member to aid them in their pursuit of higher education during the 2025-2026 school year. Scholarships are a single monetary reward to be applied to the cost of tuition, books, and/or lab fees (if applicable). The Volt Credit Union Scholarship is open to members who plan to continue their education at an accredited university, college or technical school. Volt Credit Union employees, Board and Committee Members, and their spouses or children are not eligible for the scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a member of Volt Credit Union with an account in your name.
- Must be planning to attend an accredited college, university or technical college in the United States as a full time student in 2025-2026.
- Must provide verification of acceptance to a school before scholarship funds are disbursed.

Application Requirements

Eligible Members must complete and return the following materials no later than Monday, March 31, 2025.

- 🐇 Scholarship application form
- Photo of the applicant. (Photo will not be used for judging purposes. Photo may be used to announce the winner).
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, a guidance counselor, employer or member of the clergy. The letter should include the author's relationship to the applicant and how long they have known the applicant.
- An essay on: "Imagine that you are talking with a friend. Explain to them the value of your credit union membership." The essay should be no more than 500 words in length, and must be typed and double spaced.

Award Information

The winners will be notified by telephone or mail on or before April 19, 2025 and invited to Volt Credit Union's Annual Membership Meeting for special recognition. Scholarship funds will be sent to the post-secondary school in the student's name upon confirmation of enrollment.
